Color Mixing

Your kit contains the primary colors plus white, black and turquoise. The primaries can be mixed in various combinations to form secondary colors like orange, green and purple. You can also create tertiary colors like red-purple, blue-green and so on. Add black or white to darken or lighten.

A few things to keep in mind while mixing colors:

- 1. You do have a limited amount of paint. Start with smaller amounts when mixing until you have reached your desired color to help save paint.
- 2. Darker colors like blue and black are strong. You'll probably need way less than you think, so start easy.
- 3. Try to decide on a color palette before starting. You can look up "mid century modern color palettes" on f.ex google. We have included some suggestions as well.
